Financials:

Paxton-Buckley-Loda Community Unit School District #10 moved and Bismark-Henning CUSD #1 seconded the motion to approve financials through May 28, 2020. The financials show income as \$1,892,292.02 and total expenses totaling \$1,475,310.37 for an actual net monthly income of \$416,981.65. Balance in the trust account is \$493,604.93. Unpaid claims total \$0 and total claims for the month total \$976,414.90.

Discuss and vote on Tiering Assignment Calculation:

GCMS Community Unit School District #5 moved and Paxton-Buckley-Loda Community Unit School District #10 seconded the motion to approve the new tiering assignment calculation model. Kelly Grebinsky went over the new tiering calculation model at last month's meeting. This calculation is more complex than the one previously used in prior years and the tiering adjustments are based on demographics and historical experience of each individual school district. The 2020 base Plan is the POS \$2500, 80% coinsurance, \$4,000 OPM at Tier 7. There is no interest in changing the number of tiers a district can move – so this item will not be put up for a vote at the next meeting. The tiering movement will remain the same – schools can only go up or down a tier every year.

Discussion Items:

Effective July 1, 2020 Health Alliance is implementing a few changes to their formulary. Vitamin D is going to be removed from the Preventive Tier and Enbrel is going to be moved from the Preferred Specialty to Non-Preferred Specialty. Members will have to pay out of pocket for the Vitamin D drug since this is an over the counter supplement and there will be no change in the member's copay for the Enbrel since the copays are the same for both tiers, which is 50% coinsurance.

June's meeting will remain on the same date, Tuesday, June 23rd.

The Executive Board went into closed session to discuss personnel related matters and contracts.
